It is an	honor and a privilege for our orchestra to be participating in a trip to Disney. With that in
mind, t	the following guidelines have been set so that our representation of Walton High School
will be	positive and rewarding.
•	This is a Cobb County field trip. All school rules apply. Students are expected to
	exemplify responsible behavior at all times. Trip participants represent their families, our
	community, and Walton High School.

- Possession of and/or drinking alcoholic beverages, taking illegal non-prescription drugs, smoking, and vaping will not be tolerated.
- Any violation will cause immediate dismissal and return to Marietta. If your student is sent home, your family will be responsible for the costs associated with their return.
- Once a student is checked in for the trip, he/she may not be checked out from the trip for any reason until the student's returns to Walton.
- All students must travel on their assigned bus only; no switching. There will be no switching of hotel rooms or chaperone groups.
- Your Walton lanyard and Disney MagicBand must be worn at all times. On Sunday, you must wear your Disney shirt.
- Students must participate in all activates, including meals.
- Students must wear a watch and be on time (early).
- A "buddy system" must be adhered to at all times during the trip. Groups of 3 for exploring the parks.
- All personal entertainment equipment must have headphones.
- Bring jewelry and/or other valuables at your own risk.
- Students are advised to keep their spending money with them. Do not leave it in your hotel room.
- Hotel rooms are to be locked and curtains must be closed at all times.
- You are not allowed in anyone else's hotel room other that yours.
- In the hotel, do not use anything from the mini-bar, including water. Parents and students will be held responsible for paying any additional hotel bills.
- Lights out rule will be strictly enforced. After lights out, students are not to leave their rooms for any reason. If an emergency should arise, contact your assigned chaperone. Your chaperone will let you know what room they are in upon arrival at each hotel.
- Chaperones, bus drivers, student leaders, hotel staff, and Disney staff are to be shown proper respect at all times.
- You must adhere to all Walt Disney World rules.
- Keep the buses clean! Use the garbage bags on board.
- Extreme caution is advised with strangers. Do not leave our group. Never give out your room number or hotel location. Do not go anywhere with strangers.
- You are completely responsible for your belongings. Do not expect anyone else to unload or carry your baggage and/or equipment. Have all luggage and instruments clearly marked with your required baggage tag.
