# Safety

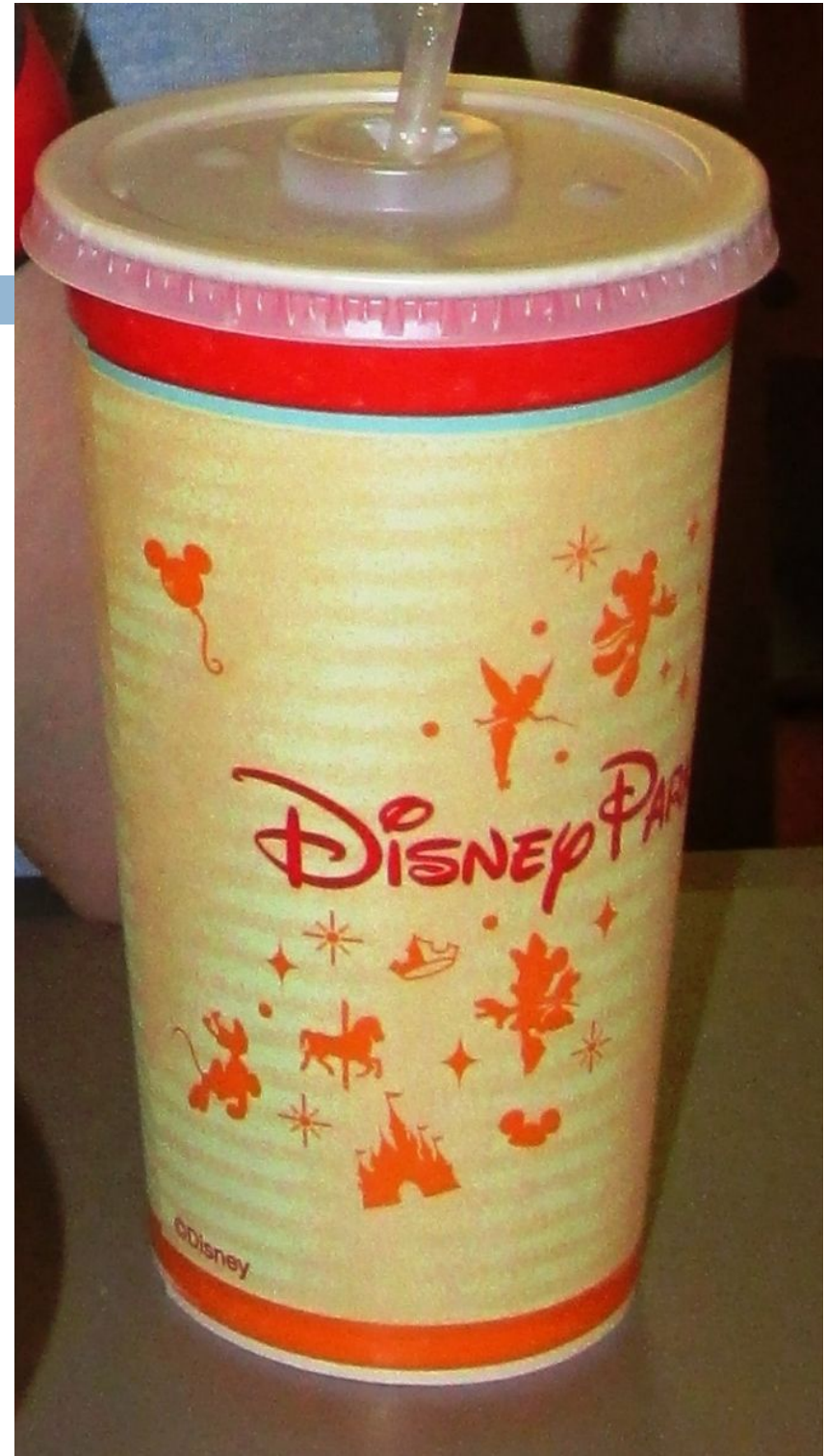


- Stay with our group. You will stay with our group from the time we leave Walton until we return, even if your parent is at Disney World too.
