Assignment

- 1) **Everyone:** We will spend the next two weeks focusing on Johann Sebastian Bach. Please watch the video from Doc talking about Bach that is linked on the orchestra Facebook page or here <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=u91-S-TL7o&feature=youtu.be>



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- 2) **With an Instrument:** You will learn one of the following solos. Pick at or above your current class level. All solos are in Charms.
- Ionian, Dorian, Aeolian, Locrian: Air, BWV 1068
 - Sinfonia: Musette, BWV Anh 126
 - Chamber & Philharmonia: Ich steh mit einem Fub im Gabe: BWV 156
 - Anyone with private teachers: solo Bach you are working on with your teacher
- This week:** you will practice your solo and record a total of 80 minutes of practice in Charms Practice Log. Ideas for practice
- Listen to a recording.
 - Clap and count the rhythm.
 - Write in the rhythm.
 - Play a scale in the key of the piece.
 - Isolate measure by measure.
 - Play rhythms on an open string.
- 3) **Without an Instrument:** You will listen to four Bach pieces. After your listen to all 4, go to Charms Message Board and answer BOTH questions (two separate topic boards).
